On the ground among the animals

Marina Caneve invests the art center with her first solo exhibition in France.

The photographs presented are from the *On the ground among the animals* corpus, a project inspired by Natura 2000, a network of ecological corridors for the preservation of biodiversity promoted by the European Union.

In this way, she creates a visual link between the infrastructures linking wild animals, those of monitoring systems and the landscapes of nature reserves. The artist thus addresses key themes such as migration and freedom of movement, the conservation of ecosystems and, ultimately, the possibility of rethinking the role of humans in the world.
